Guidelines for Authors

- 1. Please send the paper in digital form via e-mail to vgi@ovq.at.
- 2. If you include mathematics, formulae or additional characters (e.g. Greek letters) in the text, you have to send a PDF-file.
- 3. Text format: ASCII or MS-Word. The final formatting will be done according to the existing layout rules during the print layout, thus please neither hyphenation nor formatting of any kind (indentions, tabulators, bold, italic, underlined, columns, etc.). If you have any suggestions for formatting the article, please send a pdf-file.
- 4. For the full paper we need:
 - Ø title of the publication
 - Ø names of the authors
 - Ø one digital picture for each author (e.g. passport photo)
 - Ø abstract in English (and German if possible)
 - Ø keywords (max. 5)
 - Ø text part (max. 6000 words please structure clearly the serially numbered headings and subheadings) including formulae and tables
 - Ø bibliographic references numbered serially and in square brackets
 - Ø address of the authors (title, name, postal address and e-mail)
 - Ø figures and tables
 - Ø please notice that we accept only 1st publication
- 5. Please integrate mathematical formulae into the word file if possible. If not send the formulae separately and make a note in the text. In this case please send a pdf-copy of the text, too.
- 6. Figures and Tables
 - Ø Number consecutively beginning with 1 and mention at least once in the text.
 - Ø Give the titles of the figures and tables at the end of the text separately.
 - Ø Mark the position of the figures or tables in the text.
 - \emptyset Send the figures as separate files and not integrated into the text. Use established bitmap formats (JPG, TIF, GIF).
 - \emptyset The size of the figures can be 69 mm or 143 mm broad, exceptionally it might also be 205 mm, and a maximum height of 143 mm.
 - ${\tt Ø}$ Please mention complex tables separately at the end of the text.
- 7. Please get the permission to publish quotations or pictures from the original authors and add the respective list of references. The responsibility rests with the author.
